



CCMS CONSULTATION DOCUMENT REGARDING THE PROPOSAL TO EXPAND ENROLMENT NUMBERS AT ST MARY'S PRIMARY SCHOOL, BANBRIDGE

1.0 Context

1.1 The need to address oversubscription in Mid-Armagh and Banbridge was identified in the 2017-18 Annual Action for Area Planning. In August 2018 Council for Catholic Maintained Schools (CCMS) agreed to consult on options to meet the demand for Catholic Education places.

2.0 Current Position

2.1 St Mary's Primary School (PS), Banbridge, is the only CCMS primary school in Banbridge. A new 14 class building opened in September 2017 to accommodate the current approved enrolment of 407. As a result of increased numbers of pupils applying to the school the current enrolment is 503.

2.2 The Department of Education (DE) census, live birth data and enrolment trends indicate continued annual pressure on enrolment numbers in Mid-Armagh and Banbridge.

2.3 At present, the increased enrolment demands are met through Temporary Variations (TVs) where the school requests DE's permission to increase the approved enrolment number. These requests must be made annually and do not entitle the school to additional accommodation.

2.4 CCMS is consulting with governors, parents/guardians, staff and other stakeholders on expanding enrolment numbers within St Mary's PS, Banbridge, to provide for an increase to the enrolment/admissions number to 496-525.

3.0 Capital Investment

3.1 If the expansion proposal is agreed, CCMS will work closely with DE to secure the appropriate capital funding to adjust the accommodation provision within St Mary's PS, Banbridge.

4.0 Regulatory Standards

4.1 The DE policy **Primary Schools Schedules of Accommodation (Edition 2 June 2011)** determines the size of schools based on enrolment numbers and the requirements of a modern education establishment.

4.2 This consultation is seeking to increase the class-base in the school to **18** to reflect an admissions/enrolment of 496-525.

4.3 Table 1 below confirms the enrolment numbers since 2013/14

5.0 Equality

6.0 Proposal

6.1 St Mary's PS, Banbridge:

- 5.2 The current enrolment is 503 including pupils with Special Educational Needs statements equates to an 18 class-based school (enrolment 496-525).
- 6.3 CCMS is consulting on the proposal to increase the admissions/enrolment of St Mary's PS, Banbridge, from its current 381 – 410 to 496-525 to an 18 class-based school.

7.0 Consultation Process

- 7.1 A written consultation format will apply to determine the views of governors, staff, parent/guardians of the pupils and other stakeholders on the proposal.
- 7.2 A copy of this consultation document has been issued to governors, staff, parent/guardians of the pupils and other stakeholders to seek comments on the proposal to increase the enrolment numbers at St Mary's PS, Banbridge from the current 407 to an enrolment entitlement of 496-525 pupils
