

Key Stage 2 Homework Policy

- Pupils should be able to complete their homework independently and should therefore be encouraged to read the instructions before beginning the activity.
- All homework should take no more than 45mins. There will be a gradual increase from 30mins in term 1 P5 to 45mins in term 3.
- Presentation is very important. Homework should always be given a title and a date.
- Homework are differentiated in relation to content and time to cater for all abilities.



Homework Nights

Monday to Thursday



Every Night

Reading; Parents/guardians need to listen to their child read each night and question them on what they've just read or discuss new vocabulary.

Spellings; Spellings need to be learned each night. Test books should be signed when corrections have been completed and returned to school.

At Regular Intervals

Revise number facts, especially multiplication/division tables.

High frequency words.

Primary 5

Beginning in term 1 with one written homework each night with occasionally one other, progressing to maths each night and usually one other written activity.

Primary 6

Maths written homework each night and usually one other.

Primary 7

Monday to Wednesday night=Maths written homework and usually one other.

Thursday night= Revision activities.
