## St Mary's Visitor Policy COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS)

In response to the global coronavirus outbreak, St Mary's Primary School, has implemented a strict visitor policy to safeguard the health and wellbeing of the whole school community.

In line with Covid 19 Public Health Agency Guidance, <u>please do not visit the school</u> if you display any symptoms.

The symptoms of COVID-19 are:

- A new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual); or
- A high temperature/fever this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature); or
- A loss of or change in sense of smell or taste.

If your visit to St Mary's is essential you must;

- Sanitise your hands on entry.
- Report to reception and sign the school visitors' book.
- Wear a face mask or covering at all times.
- Adhere to social distancing of 2m.
- Adhere to the school's staff Code of Conduct at all times.
- In the interests of Safeguarding visitors must not use a mobile phone or a camera in the school building or on site when children are present.
- Smoking is strictly prohibited on any area of the school site.
