P4 to P7 Registration

Dear Parent/Carer

Parents must only send their child/ren to school if they cannot make alternative arrangements. Parents should not send their children to school if a parent is at home.

Parents <u>must register</u> their child/ren if they wish to send their child/ren to school from Monday 15<sup>th</sup> March. Children of *key workers* and *vulnerable* children have access to 'supervised learning' within an appropriate age group bubble at St Mary's. Normal school times will operate for each year group. Doors will open from 8.45am.

Please make Afterschool Club bookings in the normal way.

Parents <u>must not</u> send their child/children to school if they have any Covid-19 symptoms including:

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste.

A confirmed positive Covid-19 case may result in the closure of the group bubble for 2 weeks and children needing to self-isolate for 10 days.
